  - Your banker is there to help you with whatever comes your way. If you are confused, don't be afraid to ask questions.

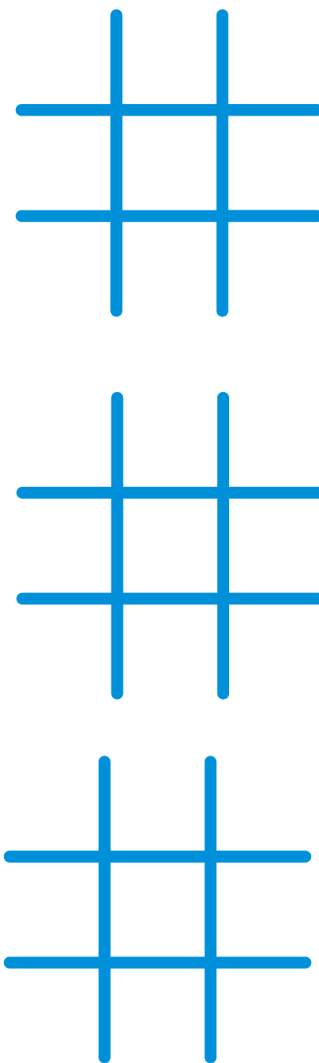
